SUMMARY OF RULES

- \* Play to commence at 1:30pm, a forfeit of the first set may be claimed on any set not begun by 1:40pm. Rule 11.
- \* Sets are to be played in the order outlined in Rule 9.
- \* If play is interrupted by rain for more than 1 hour between 1:30pm and 5:00pm the match is cancelled. Play may be abandoned at any stage due to rain by agreement of both Captains. The Captain of the HOME team shall decide whether or not the courts are suitable for play.
- \* If the 11:00am ABC radio news on the day of play indicates the temperature for the day of 37° or higher, play is abandoned and points shared. In the case of finals, matches will be re-scheduled.
- \* If play is cancelled or abandoned, a score card signed by both Captains must be lodged by the home team.
- \* Tie breakers in all sets are played at 6 games all.
- \* Teams must play all players in ranked order. If an interchange player comes in to the team, he/she must play in the correct ranked order.
- \* If an unregistered player plays with permission of the Executive, this must be recorded in the section provided on the score card. If full information is not supplied, all that player's sets will be forfeited.
- \* If permission to play an unregistered player has not been obtained, all that players sets will be forfeited and recorded as "0 - 6"
- \* The FULL NAME of each player, including the interchange player, is to be neatly written on the score card.
- \* Teams may use NO MORE than one interchange player of each gender, ie, may use one of each. Interchange players names MUST be written on the score card prior to the commencement of play.
- \* An interchange player MUST play at least one full set to be recorded as a playing day (for finals qualifying purposes). See also Rule 9
