

## 2009 Queensland State Titles

A fleet of eleven of the twelve entrants faced the starters during the 2009 TS16 Queensland State Titles over the weekend of October 3 - 4. Unfortunately Norm Thompson fell ill after arriving at Noosaville for his annual trek to the Lake. We all hope Norm has fully recovered by the time this news goes to print.

### **Heat 1:**

Race 1 started in a light to moderate NNW wind that oscillated throughout the race. There was a bunch of boats arriving at the top mark first time around with Jackpot getting the best of it and sailing clear to win followed by Ally-Oop and Plan B.

### **Heat 2:**

Similar conditions prevailed as in Heat 1 with Jackpot once again dominating the race followed by Plan B and a nicely selected gust assisted Time to manage to duck into third place.

### **Heat 3.**

A swing in the breeze at the first mark created some havoc with a number of boats arriving on port tack in the middle of a lift, which caused the starboard approaching boats to require a reassessment of their approach to the mark. After it was all sorted out, with some hasty tacking and evasive manoeuvres and a couple of bumps, Jackpot once again sprang to the lead and sailed clear with Uncle Roy in pursuit followed by Ally-Oop.

### **Heat 4:**

With the forecast strong south easterly failing to materialize in strength, the race was sailed in a moderate breeze. Once again the oscillations favoured some with Scaliwag managing to lead at the first mark slightly ahead of the bunch but was mowed down by Jackpot before completing the first triangle with Ally-Oop and Time not far behind. Once again Jackpot held the lead to the finish line and Ally-Oop managed to pip Scaliwag right on the finish line for second.

### **Heat 5:**

The breeze for race 5 was similar to race 4. Jackpot once again was first around the windward mark with Ally-Oop and Plan B close astern. As the race progressed the first four boats had some close tussles with Ally-Oop actually getting the better of Jackpot for a short while. However the consistent good sailing by the Jackpot crew prevailed and went on to win from Ally-Oop closely followed by Plan B and Uncle Roy.

Congratulations to the Jackpot team as they proved their superiority once again and thoroughly deserved to win the title. The handicap series win went to Scuttlebutt.
